

NELSON AIR QUALITY PLAN
- PUBLIC NOTICE OF PROPOSED PLAN CHANGE A3

Clause 5, First Schedule, Resource Management Act 1991 (RMA)

Proposed Plan Change A3 'Woodburner Plan Change' relates to the Nelson Air Quality Plan.

WHAT THE PROPOSAL COVERS

1. Provision for Ultra Low Emission Burners (ULEBs) to be installed in some houses which don't currently have woodburners, specifically:
 - 1000 ULEBs in Airshed B2
 - 600 ULEBs in Airshed C.
2. Provision for Council to authorise an increase in ULEB installations in specific airsheds in future, when improvements in air quality have occurred in that area.
3. Inclusion of a definition for Ultra Low Emission Burners (ULEBs).
4. Inclusion of a new Appendix setting out the minimum requirements for a ULEB, including the certification process that must be followed in conjunction with the building consent.

WHERE THE PROPOSAL MAY BE INSPECTED

The proposed plan change document and the accompanying reports are available for public inspection at the Customer Service Centre, Nelson libraries and on the council website www.nelson.govt.nz (search phrase: Woodburner Plan Change).

SUBMISSIONS

The proposed plan change is open for submissions until 5pm on **Wednesday 17 February 2016**.

Anyone can make a submission, in paper or electronic format. Submission forms are available on the website, at the Customer Service Centre and in the Nelson libraries. You don't need to use the submission form provided, but you do need to provide the same information as that requested on the form.
