How do I purchase tickets?

Can I buy a ticket on the day of the event?

• Yes, tickets can be purchased cashless at the gate, Eftpos only.

What does it cost?

- Early bird adult \$25 (Until Friday 3rd Jan)
- Full Price Adult \$35 (Saturday 4th Jan)
- Children aged 5-15 years \$9
- Children under 5 FREE

Tickets purchased from any other source may be unauthorised copies and may be refused admittance to the event. If an event is postponed, purchased tickets for the original date will be valid for the new date unless otherwise advised.
